We are accepting clients for our **12-session Cognitive Behavioral Anger Management Program**. In addition to those that desire to learn methods to control their anger, ideal participants include those on probation, and/or diagnosed with mental health and/or substance abuse issues.

This program consists of face-to-face educational training in a group setting. Counselors who have received training on this subject matter will lead all sessions. Each participant will receive education on anger, with respect given to triggering events, recognizing cues of anger and development of anger management strategies in response to those events and cues. In addition to lecture, each participant will receive a complimentary anger management workbook that is aligned to topics presented and used to facilitate self-reflection and homework assignments.

A **Certificate of Completion** will be awarded to those completing ALL sessions and having paid fees associated at the conclusion of this program.

Substance Abuse

We are accepting clients for our **ASAM Level I Outpatient Substance Abuse Treatment Program**. This program will operate as an open group, where participants enter and/or leave group at various time. Level I outpatient services are designed to treat the individual's level of clinical severity and to help that individual achieve permanent changes in his or her alcohol/drug-using behavior and mental functioning. To accomplish this, services must address major lifestyle, attitudinal, and behavioral issues that have the potential to undermine the goals of treatment or inhibit that individual's ability to cope with major life tasks without the non-medical use of alcohol or other drugs. Treatment is:

- Between 3–9 hours a week
- Based on the Prime Solutions® curriculum
- Includes mandatory random drug screenings (saliva, urine or hair follicle), and/or alcohol breath scans.
- Although not include in treatment time, AA, NA and/or similar program participation is mandatory
